I am excited to see what transpires from God's plans for the community. We look forward to seeing everybody at the local church and community events.

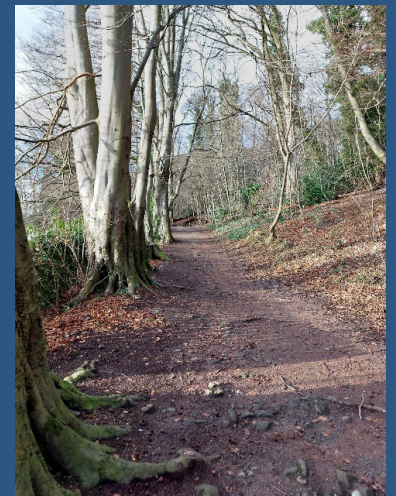
